\$10 billion dollar school facilities bond that would require local matching funds. A double tax whamy.

Proposition 3 ✗ VOTE NO (VCTA takes no position)

The U.S. Supreme Court settled Law regarding marriage between same sex marriages. This proposition attempts to change the California Constitution language and law regarding the definition of marriage and the right to marry.

Proposition 4 ✗ VOTE NO

\$10 billion dollars for "climate change" will balloon into \$20 billion or more with no objective evaluations to assess the return on the investment. California already operates with a deficit.

Proposition 5 ✗ VOTE NO

This is another attempt at an end-run that would cripple the effectiveness of Prop 13 passed in 1978. This measure would lower the threshold for bond approvals from 66.7% to 55% making future bonds far easier to pass, costing taxpayers billions.

Proposition 6 ✗ VOTE NO

If passed this bill would essentially give prisoners the right to form unions.

Proposition 32 ✗ VOTE NO

Would raise the minimum wage from \$16 to \$18 further harming small businesses and eliminating entry level jobs for young people and semi-skilled workers.

Proposition 33 ✗ VOTE NO

Rent control. Voters rejected similar bills in 2018 and 2020.

Proposition 34 ✗ VOTE NO

This seems to be more of a rent control and misappropriation of public funded AIDs drug allocation issue.

Proposition 35 ✗ VOTE NO

Redirects managed care organization taxes to fund healthcare including free healthcare for 1.5 to 2 million illegal aliens.

Proposition 36 ✓ VOTE YES

Begins to unwind the damage done by Prop 47 passed 10 years ago. It was meant to reduce California's overcrowded prisons by turning some drug and theft crimes into misdemeanors but instead fueled shoplifting sprees and related crimes, driving up retailers' insurance costs and cost to consumers.
